


## Early Childhood Programs

## Preschool Curriculum

The Great Start Readiness Program is a free preschool program funded by the Michigan State Department of Education for four-year-olds who have identified risks for academic difficulties, and are from low-income families.

Preschoolers must reside within Wayne County. Residents residing within the Dearborn Heights School District #7 will be given preference.

Our primary goal is to provide a high quality preschool experience that will prepare them socially, emotionally, cognitively and physically for kindergarten, school success, and for life.

The Great Start Readiness Program's curriculum is based on the characteristics and traits typical of the ages and stages of the children being taught. Numerous findings from studies focused on early childhood development have taught us that young children learn most easily from concrete experiences and the use of three dimensional manipulative materials. Productive learning is interesting, relevant, satisfying, challenging and fun!



The Great Start Readiness Program preschool provides opportunities for children to engage in oral communication and to read and write. Children will learn to appreciate language arts in large group, small group, and individual settings. Opportunities for key experiences in learning are presented throughout the day

## Early Years Child Care

Dearborn Heights School District #7 offers a comprehensive early years child care program to meet the needs of working parents and their children.

The program offers a preschool program targeting social and cognitive skills. The program is a blend of strong curriculum-based activities in a social learning environment. Through structured centers, group activities, singing, play and a great deal of fun, we work to prepare our young students for their next stage of development.



Of all our childhood programs, The Early Years Child Care is a fee based program with a minimum of four hours per day three days a week. The fee is assessed bi-monthly.
